

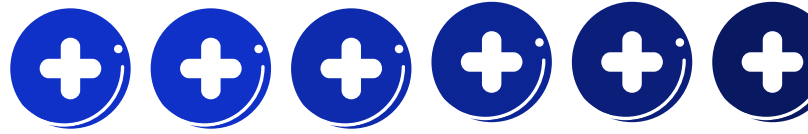


Out of Pocket Costs

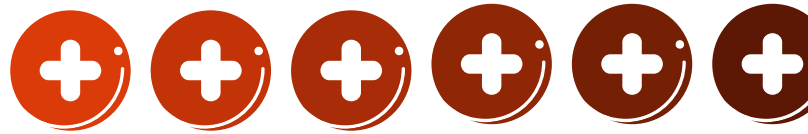
